5th Annual Paint Out Guidelines

When: Saturday, August 24th, rain or shine.

Theme: This year's theme is Beautiful Skaneateles Lake.

What: Register online any time before the event, or at the John D. Barrow Art Gallery on Saturday morning. Paint en plein aire in the Skaneateles area (see location information below), using any painting or drawing media. **Bring your finished artwork to Anyela's Vineyard, 2433 West Lake Road, Skaneateles by 5 PM on Saturday, to display it for prizes and possible sale.**

Where: View the [Finger Lakes Land Trust map](#) for location ideas, and a list of private properties that will allow registered artists access to their properties on August 24th, all day, to create artwork for the Paint Out event. Please be respectful of all sites!

Prizes/People's Choice Awards:

- \$200 in Adult (age 18 and up) category
- \$50 in the Under 18 category

Event Guidelines:

- 1) This is a hand-made art event; no photography, computer generated art, or other machine-generated work please.
- 2) Up to three (3) entries per registered artist will be allowed.
- 3) Finished art size is limited to 24" framed or unframed.
- 4) Each piece of art must be labelled on the back with the name of the artist, and if for sale, the price set by the artist.
- 5) Artwork will be on display before and during the Skaneateles Festival's Saturday evening concert. All concert goers will be invited to help select the People's Choice awards, and the winners will be announced at intermission.
- 6) Artwork will be available for pick up at intermission or at the John D. Barrow Art Gallery, 49 East Genesee Street, the following day (Sunday, August 25th) between 1 and 4 PM. Artwork will not be held past 4 PM on August 25th!
- 7) In case of rain, the concert and Paint Out exhibition may be moved to Skaneateles High School, 49 East Elizabeth Street. Go to the Skaneateles Festival website at <http://www.skandfest.org> the afternoon of August 24th to confirm location.
